
Colorado Qualifying House 2024 ANNUAL REPORT









The Colorado Qualifying House is a group home located in the Colorado Rocky Mountains, serving male youth who are preparing to transition into adulthood and reintegrate into the community.

Youth at the Q-House engage in a structured daily routine that includes therapeutic groups, recreation, community service, school attendance, and employment in the community. Treatment services include Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT), Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT), and Positive Skill Development (PSD) groups.

2024 Outcomes

- 18 years old was the average age in 2024
- 86% of discharges were successful exits
- 4.8 average family contacts per youth each month
- 31.8 hours of Positive Youth Development (PYD) programming provided per youth each week
